





- 1. REMOVE THE (2) PLASTIC RIVETS THAT FASTEN THE FASCIA TABS TO THE VEHICLE. NOTE: REMOVE THE CENTER OF THE RIVET WITH A SCREWDRIVER. RIVETS TO BE REINSTALLED.
- 2. LOWER THE EXHAUST BY REMOVING BOLT ON THE CLAMP AROUND THE CENTER OF THE MUFFLER.
- 3. REMOVE THE GROUND STRAP FROM THE MUFFLER. NUT TO BE REINSTALLED.
- 4. REMOVE THE TWO SCREWS THAT ATTACH THE HEAT SHIELD TO THE FRAME. RETURN THE HEAT SHIELD AND SCREWS TO CUSTOMER.
- 5. RAISE THE HITCH INTO POSITION.
- 6. LOOSELY INSTALL THE 12mm HEX BOLTS AND CONICAL TOOTHED WASHERS AS SHOWN. NOTE: POSITION HITCH AS FAR OVER TO THE DRIVER'S SIDE AS POSSIBLE FOR MAXIMUM MUFFLER CLEARANCE.
- 6. TIGHTEN ALL BOLTS.

TIGHTEN M12 CL8.8 FASTENERS TO 76 LB.-FT.

- 7. REINSTALL GROUND STRAP.
- 8. REINSTALL THE MUFFLER.
- 9. REINSTALL PLASTIC RIVETS TO FASCIA.
