

2011-12 Hyundai Sonata (No Foglights) Installation Instructions

Please read BOTH these Installation Instructions and the General Instructions before attempting to install or operate this equipment.

- Blue Ox® towing products and accessories are intended to be installed by Blue Ox® Dealers who are familiar with our products and have the equipment and knowledge to do "fit work". When necessary Blue Ox® Dealers can be found at www.blueox.com or by contacting our Customer Care Department at (402) 385-3051.
- 2. Many Blue Ox® Baseplates are designed to use existing holes and hardware to mount the baseplate to the towed vehicle. Even though bolts are there, do not assume they are adequate for baseplate mounting. Always use hardware supplied in the hardware kit or existing hardware specified in the Baseplate Towing Installation Instructions.

Confirm the towability and pre-towing procedures for your vehicle with the owner's manual or contact the vehicle's manufacturer for specific towing procedures.



Important:

Use only genuine factory replacement parts on your baseplate. Do **NOT** substitute homemade or non-typical parts. If a bolt is lost or in need of replacement, for your safety and the preservation of your baseplate, be sure to use a replacement bolt of the same grade (In most cases it will be Grade 5, please reference the parts list above). Replacement parts may be ordered through your nearest Blue Ox® Dealer or Distributor. Failing to follow and/or altering these installation instructions in either installation or required equipment will void the manufacturer's warranty. Towing behind a non-motorized vehicle will void the warranty.



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Attachment Tabs:

Due to the design of the removable tabs, the RangeFinderII tow bar can not be used. Adapters, except the BX8833 and BX88151, can not be used with this baseplate.

Instructions:

The front fascia, and washer reservoir are removed for the baseplate installation. Drilling is required. Trimming of the frame and air dam is required.


The dimensional variations between otherwise identical vehicles can be considerable. While the baseplate was designed for easy installation, it may be necessary to tailor the baseplate slightly to compensate for auto manufacturer's tolerances. These minor adjustments may include filing a hole slightly, bending electrical rods or bending end plates.

The BX8869 Bulb and Socket Wiring Kit is available for this vehicle.




Possible Location of the EXECO Bulb & Socket Within Kit

Installation Instructions:



1. Just forward of front tire, on the edge of the wheel well remove the bolt with a 10MM socket or a Phillips screw driver, both sides.




Just forward of front tire on the lower edge of the fascia are two Phillips push pins to remove with the Phillips screw driver, both sides.

Handling of some cosmetic parts when installing this product may require the use of protective covers, rags, specialty tools, etc. to prevent damage.






3. Remove the metric bolt from the corner of the top edge of the fascia, just above the headlight with a 10MM socket, both sides.



4. Remove the six Phillips push pins from the top of the fascia.



5. Pull fascia's corner out to the side to release the clips, pull fascia forward both sides, unplug all electrical components if necessary and set fascia aside carefully.



6. On the driver's side, press the button on the side of the coax junction to loosen. Unclip from the back three christmas tree pins and move out of the way.







7. Using a reciprocating saw cut straight across the top of the hole and on the inside edge of the hole straight down. Do this on both sides.



 On the passenger side, unplug the hoses from the washer reservoir and cap. Using a 10MM socket, remove one bolt on each side. Pull the washer reservoir off and set aside to be reinstalled later.




9. Mark a line on the inner edge of the air dam, 3 1/2" up from the bottom edge and cut straight up the crease. Cut straight out 2" to the edge. Remove this area with the reciprocating saw, both sides.



10. Slide the baseplate on to the frame rail to align with the existing hole for the washer reservoir on the passenger's side, and clamp the baseplate to the frame rail on both sides with the vise grip. Baseplate should measure 1/2" from the top of the frame ribbing down to the top edge of baseplate and as far forward as possible, both sides.







11. Using the baseplate as a template, drill five holes with the 13/32" drill bit.

When using power drills be aware of the dangers of torque and drill bit length.

BE SURE TO USE LOCTITE® RED ON ALL BOLTS BEFORE TIGHTENING. TIGHTEN ALL BOLTS ACCORDING TO THE TORQUE CHART ON THE FRONT PAGE OF THESE INSTRUCTIONS OR ON PAGE 3 OF THE BASEPLATE GENERAL TOWING INSTRUCTIONS.



13. Insert 3/8-16 x 1 1/4" hex bolts and 3/8" lock washers into baseplate bottom two holes to align with 3/8-16 lock nuts tighten with the 9/16" socket, both sides. Be sure to use Loctite on all bolts.



12. Insert the nut plates into the end of frame rail, just behind metal bumper bracket to align with the top three drilled holes, insert 3/8-16 x 1 1/4" hex bolts and 3/8" lock washers into baseplate drilled holes with the 9/16" socket, both sides. Be sure to use Loctite on all bolts.




14. Attach the permanent baseplate safety cables to the provided convenience link on the baseplate (see grey arrow). The photo above shows the recommended installation of the cables to frame of vehicle (see white arrow). Additional options may interfere with suggested mounting; in this case secure the cables to a solid piece of the frame as described in the instructions included with the permanent baseplate safety cables. Be sure the safety cables do not rub against any hoses or moving parts. Do this to both sides of the vehicle.





15. Reinstall the washer reservoir on the passenger side, using the existing bolts. Be sure that all the electrical connections and hoses are plugged in properly.



16. Position the flat behind the breakaway bracket and attach with 1/4-20 x 3/4" bolts and 1/4" lock washers. Reinstall fascia. **Be sure all electrical components are plugged in properly.**



17. Location for the 4 or 6 pin electrical coupler on the fascia's lower air dam just below license plate.

Be sure that ALL electrical connections are plugged in properly and functioning BEFORE Installing the fascia.

- 18. The dimensional variations between otherwise identical cars can be considerable. While the baseplate was designed for easy installation, it may be necessary to tailor the baseplate slightly to compensate for auto manufacturers' tolerances. These minor adjustments may include filing a hole slightly, bending electrical rods, adding and/or bending endplates.
- 19. Install the tow bar and safety cables according to the instructions included in their packages.
- 20. Do **not** substitute other devices if the tow bar pin and clip are lost.
- 21. DEALER OR INSTALLER: BE CERTAIN THE USER RECEIVES THE INSTRUCTION SHEET.
