

Baseplate Installation Instructions

Please read BOTH these Installation Instructions and the General Instructions before attempting to install or operate this equipment.

- Blue Ox® towing products and accessories are intended to be installed by Blue Ox®
 Dealers who are familiar with our products and have the equipment necessary and knowledge to do "fit work". When necessary Blue Ox®
 Dealers can be found at www.blueox.us or by contacting our Customer Care
 Department at (402) 385-3051.
- 2. Many Blue Ox® Baseplates are designed to use existing holes and hardware to mount the baseplate to the towed vehicle. Even though bolts are there, do not assume they are adequate for baseplate mounting. Always use hardware supplied in the hardware kit and existing hardware specified in the Baseplate Installation Instructions.

Confirm the towability and pre-towing procedures for your vehicle with the owner's manual or contact the vehicle's manufacturer for specific towing procedures. You can also contact REMCO for additional information at 1(800)228-2481.



Important:

Use only genuine factory replacement parts on your baseplate. Do **NOT** substitute homemade or non-typical parts. If a bolt is lost or in need of replacement, for your safety and the preservation of your baseplate, be sure to use a replacement bolt of the same grade (In most cases it will be Grade 5, please reference the parts list above). Replacement parts may be ordered through your nearest Blue Ox® Dealer or Distributor, or call our 24/7 Customer Care Team at (402)385-3051.

Attachment Tabs:

Motorhome mount tow bars are recommended for use with this baseplate. Due to the design of the removable tabs, the RangeFinder II, Adventurer and Ambassador tow bars can not be used. The Acclaim tow bar mat be used, but will not fold and on the front of the vehicle. Adapters, except the BX8833 and BX88151, can not be used with this baseplate.

Instructions:

The front fascia, fog lights, horn brackets, Styrofoam bumper, and metal bumper are removed for the baseplate installation. Lower metal bumper cross bar will not be re-installed.

The dimensional variations between otherwise identical vehicles can be considerable. While the baseplate was designed for easy installation, it may be necessary to tailor the baseplate slightly to compensate for auto manufacturer's tolerances. These minor adjustments may include filing a hole slightly, bending electrical rods, and/ or bending end plates.

The Bx8869 Bulb and Socket Wiring Kit is recommended for this vehicle.



Remove six push pins from the top of the fascia.
Set push pins aside to be re-installed later.



 Remove four push pins from the under the front fascia. You will need to remove the push pin indicated by the grey arrow and pull back the webbing to expose the fourth push pin. This is done on both sides of the vehicle, the driver's side is shown. Set push pins aside to be re-installed later.




3. Remove one push pin from the top of the wheel well. This is done to both sides of the vehicle, the driver's side is shown.

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4. On the underside of the front fascia, in the center, remove one push pin. Set it aside to be re-installed later. Unplug the fog lights, and pull the front fascia forward and set it carefully aside.



6. Set metal bumper on a flat surface, remove two lower metric bolts from the bumper bracket with a 12MM Socket. This is done on both sides of the vehicle, the driver's side is shown. Discard the lower cross bar (see grey arrow). Lower metal cross bar will NOT be re-installed.



5. Remove Styrofoam bumper. Remove three bolts from the metal bumper using a 14MM Socket. This is done on both sides of the vehicle, the driver's side is shown. Set bolts aside to be re-installed later. Pull metal bumper forward and carefully set it aside to be re-installed later.




7. Using a reciprocating saw, cut horizontally just under the lower bolt hole, approximately 1 1/8" up from the bottom of the webbing. Make a vertical cut so that the webbing is flush with the frame rail. This is done to both sides of the vehicle to open area for baseplate installation, the driver's side is shown.

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


 Ribbing should be flattened (see white arrow).
Bend the ribbing on the under carriage up and in to relieve the area for baseplate installation. This is done on both sides of the vehicle, the driver's side is shown.



 Using a 12MM Socket, remove one metric bolt from the horn bracket. This is done on both sides of the vehicle, the driver's side is shown. Set bolts and horn bracket aside to be re-installed later.

**BE SURE TO USE LOCTITE® RED ON ALL BOLTS BEFORE TIGHTENING. TIGHTEN ALL BOLTS ACCORDING TO THE TORQUE CHART ON PAGE 1 OF THESE INSTRUCTIONS OR ON PAGE 3 OF THE BASEPLATE TOWING GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS.



10. Align the top three holes on the endplates with the existing holes in the frame rail (see white arrows) and clamp baseplate to the frame with large vise grip. It may be necessary to ream the holes slightly to allow the bolts to clear. Drill the two lower holes in the frame with 13/32" Drill Bit (see grey arrows). This is down to both sides of the vehicle, the driver's side is shown.



11. Insert the 3/8-16 nut plate into the front opening of the frame rail, line up with the top three holes in the baseplate and install 3/8-16 x 1 1/2" hex bolts and 3/8" Lock Washers (see white arrows in photo 10). After bolts are tight, cut the wires from the nut plates. Install the 3/8-16 x 1 1/4 hex bolts into the two lower holes using the 3/8" Locker Washers and the 3/8-16 Whiz Nuts (see grey arrows in photo 10). After the bolts are tight cut the wire from the whiz nuts. This is done to both sides of the vehicle. The driver's side is shown.

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- 12. On the metal bumper (see white arrow) measure 1/4" up from the bottom and using a reciprocating saw, trim off section. This is done on both sides of the metal bumper, the driver's side is shown.
- 13. Re-install Styrofoam and metal bumpers according to Step 5.
- 14. Re-install the horn bracket according to Step 9.
- 15. Plug the fog lights back in.




16. Hold the front fascia up to its original position, mark and trim the bottom of the fascia approximately 1" up from the bottom on each side and in the center near tab (see arrow). Be sure that ALL electrical connections are plugged in properly and functioning BEFORE Installing the fascia.

- 17. Reinstall front fascia according to the instructions on the previous pages (Steps 1-4).
- 18. Install the tow bar and safety cables according to their instructions. When demonstrating this to the customer, be sure to include all Blue Ox packages and their contents.
- 19. **DO NOT** substitute other devices if the tow bar pins and clips are misplaced.
