SLE **Installation Instructions**

Please read BOTH these Installation Instructions and the General Towing Instructions before attempting to install or operate this equipment.

- Blue Ox® towing products and accessories are intended to be installed by Blue Ox® Dealers who are familiar with our products and have the equipment and knowledge to do "fit work." When necessary, Blue Ox® Dealers can be found at www.blueox.us or by contacting our 24/7 Customer Care Department at (888) 425-5382.
- 2. Many Blue Ox® Baseplates are designed to use existing holes and hardware to mount the baseplate to the towed vehicle. Even though bolts are there, do not assume they are adequate for baseplate mounting. Always use hardware supplied in the hardware kit or existing hardware specified in the Baseplate Towing Installation Instructions.

Confirm the towability and pre-towing procedures for your vehicle with the owner's manual or contact the vehicle's manufacturer for specific towing procedures. You can also contact REMCO for additional information at 1(800)228-2481.



Tools Required



Important:

Use only genuine factory replacement parts on your baseplate. Do **NOT** substitute homemade or non-typical parts. If a bolt is lost or in need of replacement, for your safety and the preservation of your baseplate, be sure to use a replacement bolt of the same grade (In most cases it will be Grade 5, please reference the parts list above). Replacement parts may be ordered through your nearest Blue Ox® Dealer or Distributor.

Vehicle Weight:

The weight of this vehicle is near the Class III, 5,000 lb. rating limitations. Some models, depending on options, may well exceed this 5,000 lb. rating. Be sure to confirm the weight of your individual vehicle before towing. As of 1999, the Aventa® II is now 10,000 lbs. and either the Aventa® II or the Aventa® LX tow bar must be used for these applications.

Tow Bar Adapters are NOT to be used with vehicles weighing over 5,000 lbs.

Installation Notes: The fascia metal bumper and air baffle are removed and reinstalled during installation of the baseplate. Drilling is required. Trimming of the fascia is required.

The dimensional variations between otherwise identical vehicles can be considerable. While the baseplate was designed for easy installation, it may be necessary to tailor the baseplate slightly to compensate for auto manufacturer's tolerances. These minor adjustments may include filing a hole slightly, bending electrical rods and/ or bending end plates.

The BX8869 Bulb and Socket Wiring Kit is recommended for this vehicle.


Installation Instructions:



 Using a Phillips flat screwdriver, remove one plastic push pin and one metric from both sides. There is also one push pin from the center by the hood latch to remove. Set push pins and bolts aside to be reinstalled later.



2. Using a Phillips flat screw driver turn the push pin horizontally then remove.



3. Using a 10MM socket, remove one metric bolt inside front wheel well on fascia's upper corner. Do this on both sides of vehicle. Set bolts aside to be reinstalled later.




Using 10MM socket, remove seven metric bolts underneath the fascia.






 Pull the styrofoam off, unclip the four clips across the top of the metal bumper. Remove the bolts with a 14MM socket from both sides. Set aside for later reinstallation.



6. Using the baseplate as a template, drill the needed holes with a 3/8" drill bit. The larger bolt is the existing hole (gray arrow). Do this to both sides.



- 7. Install nut plates through the top, and install one from the bottom (gray arrow). Reinstall metal bumper. Using the base plate as a template, drill a hole into the bottom of the metal bumper with the 13/32" drill bit, on both sides. Insert the 3/8-16 nut plate with the 12 inch wire into the opening on the front of bumper to align with drilled hole, tighten the 3/8-16 hex bolt and lock washer, on both sides.
- 8. Reinstall molded styrofoam on the front of metal bumper and fascia.
- 9. The dimensional variations between otherwise identical cars can be considerable. While the base plate was designed for easy installation, it may be necessary to tailor the baseplate slightly to compensate for auto manufacturers' tolerances. These minor adjustments may include filing a hole slightly, bending electrical rods, adding shims and/ or bending endplates.

Using a good quality paint, spray cut edges of frame to prevent rusting.

BE SURE TO USE LOCTITE® RED ON ALL BOLTS BEFORE TIGHTENING. TIGHTEN ALL BOLTS ACCORDING TO THE TORQUE CHART ON THE FRONT PAGE OF THESE INSTRUCTIONS OR ON PAGE 3 OF THE BASEPLATE TOWING GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS.

Be sure that **ALL** electrical connections are plugged in properly and functioning **BEFORE** installing the fascia.

DEALER or INSTALLER: Be certain the user receives the instruction sheets for their products.
